- a basic introduction to the interface,
- how to use JDownloader 2 for downloading videos from YouTube



Installing Java

JDownloader 2 is based on Java programming and needs the Java runtime environment. Unless you know that you already have the latest version of Java on your computer, start by going to:

Installing Java




Download and run the Java installation file.


Installing Java

When the installation finishes you have a fully updated version of Java ready on you computer.




Go to: https://jdownloader.org/download/index





This tutorial shows a Windows installation. The process may differ slightly on other systems

Clik on the link for the installer and the download will start




Depending on your browser and setup you may get ad pop-ups at this point. They have nothing to do with your installation and it is recommended to ignore them.

Open the download location and run the installer. The file for Windows is a compressed file which will now extract.


The extracted file is the actual installer that you now need to run, recognisable by name and icon.




The timestamp for the installer may place it as an older file. If not immediately visible, search for Jdownloader


Run this extracted file

When running, the installer fetches the program files




When all is ready the installation can be started






The installation wizard starts


Click on "Next"




You will get this information window



The installation directory is a default which can be changed




File associations are for various download technologies. No change is needed unless you are specifically using a file type in another program.




Select or deselect ways of starting the application

Press "Next" when ready



When the installation starts, a browser window for donations will open

Do as you feel and close the window




The installer will finish

The program will start if this was maked in "Additional tasks", if not it may be started manually later


In the following, basic use of JDownloader 2 will be shown with YouTube videos as an example.

A few tips for general use, and comments on advanced use are also included.




The Clipboad
Observer is
active by default

When a URL with downloadable content is copied, e.g. file URLs, video URLs, Clipboard Observer adds it to the download list ("Linkgrabber")




The update monitor blinks when new updates are available

JDownloader 2 frequently gets updates to keep funtionality up to par




Click to update (when not actively downloading)

Clicking "Install now" will start the update and then restart the application




This is an ad for a specific filehosting service. It has nothing to do with program functionality


After updating the program is ready (almost)




With the program ready it is time to try to download a YouTube video



Copy the URL for a YouTube video while JDownloader 2 is running




When the URL is copied, a notification like this will normally pop up at the bottom right corner of the monitor



Normally the download is now listed and can be started


However, the first time a video download is attempted a popup will notify you that a plugin is needed



FFmpeg is a known video encoder


Click "Install" to add the plugin to the program

This action is only needed once




Confirm "Install now"


The add-on is downloaded, and JDownloader 2 restarts




In this case, after adding FFmpeg, the application restarts with a download added to the "Downloads" list, and will automatically start it




In daily use, after downloads are added to the "Linkgrabber" tab, one can select and start downloads, and also deselect some of the files that were added from a URL




Open the folder that was added from as URL by clicking the "+" in order to inspect what will be downloaded



Jdownloader 2 adds all files available from from the URL, including informational text, subtitles, stills, video versions in varying qualities, and the audio track




One can deselect unneeded files, e.g. audio, or video versions in unneeded resolutions. Here, the audio file is deleted from the list (right-click in Windows or ctrl+click in Mac OS to open the context menu)




Each added URL will get its own download folder

To start a download rightclick and select "Start Downloads"




Activated downloads will move to the "Download" tab


When finished the result can be accessed by right-clicking and opening the download folder




The downloaded files are located in a subfolder in the Downloads folder



After a download has completed the links may be deleted from the "Downloads" list




By default only the links are removed, thus cleaning the list



JDownloader 2 can also download entire channels or playlists


Here the URL for an entire channel is being copied



A pop-up will ask if you want to add all playlists from a whole channel


Specific playlists can also be added in this manner

Confirm in order to proceed




Adding all files can take a while

Wait until number of files online stops counting up




Once again you can inspect the download list and deselect unnessary files

Notice several identically named image files listed here – but with different sizes




Select "Add all to Download list" to start channel download




Several files have identical names but not the same size, and they are not identical

In order to get everything, mark "Rename file" and "Remember selection ..."




Once again, when the downloads are finished you can open the directory file




And once again the downloaded files are located in a subdirectory in your Downloads folder where you may inspect and sort them

JDownloader 2 allows authentication for services, and registration for paid and privileged services.

- The former is rarely necessary, but will be shown since it may sometimes help
- The latter is only relevant with privileged access and will only be touched upon




In the "Settings" tab one can add normal user identification in the form of service URL, user email, and password. Place the cursor in the relevant field to enter account credentials



Here a YouTube account has been entered

It may help in some rare cases, but the previous use cases worked fine without this



The "Account Manager" tap is dedicated to paid and privileged accounts


TikTok may look interesting, but it needs a cookie authentication

"Account manager" is for paid and privileged accounts. One can find services such as Facebook and Vimeo listed. But functionality is dedicated to file downloads, and may not work to full satisfaction

However tempting, attempts to download accounts from TikTok resulted in this pop-up



But links for TikTok posts will work for fetching videos in JDownloader 2 without authentication

JDownloader 2 Final Words

JDownloader 2 is a powerful download manager, and can easily replace paid programs for many downloading purposes including YouTube. But it does not work for everything. Depending on your needs, other applications may be more appropriate for services where data extraction is at all possible
