

Mads Øvlisen PhD Scholarships within Art History and Practice-Based Artistic Research 2023

INTERNAL PROCESS AT IKK, 2022-2023

This winter, the deadline for applying is **12 January 2023 2:00pm (CET)**

Scholarships available for funding are within the following four research fields:

- 1 PhD scholarship within art history research before 1900 is awarded to an applicant whose research project is within the field of art history research with special emphasis on art history and/or art theory subjects from the period before 1900.
- 1 PhD scholarship within art history research after 1900 is awarded to an applicant whose research project is within the field of art history research with special emphasis on art history and/or art theory subjects from the period after 1900.
- 1 practice-based PhD scholarship in art is awarded to an applicant, whose research project is based on the applicant's artistic practice. The research project must consist of an artistic work and a written dissertation.
- 1 practice-based PhD scholarship in curating is awarded to an applicant, whose research project is based on the applicant's curatorial practice. The research project must consist of a curatorial examination and a written dissertation.

Procedure

- First, your project and qualifications will have to be pre-assessed (*prævurderet*) by Graduate School, Arts in order to find out whether or not you are qualified to hold a PhD position. If you are qualified, you will receive a declaration of interest (*interessetilkendegivelse*), and you can – in case of funding – be enrolled at Graduate School, Arts, at Aarhus University.
- Additionally, there is a question of employment. You can choose one of two:
 - Mads Øvlisen PhD scholarships with enrollment at Graduate School, Arts and *employment at IKK, Aarhus University.*
 - Mads Øvlisen PhD scholarships with enrollment at Graduate School, Arts and *employment externally.*
- You must include a hosting letter from the administrating host institution in your application. This hosting letter can either come from IKK at Aarhus University (via the research consultant) or externally (from the collaborating museum, for example). In order to get a hosting letter, the research consultant at IKK will – in any case – need to approve the budget (find template for the budget [here](#)).
