

## Consolidation, reflection and transformation

### WARCnet meeting, 3-5 November 2021

Under the heading 'Consolidation, reflection and transformation' the fourth WARCnet meeting aims to:

- Provide an overview of where we stand after the Aarhus kickoff meeting, which took place in May 2020, and the meetings in Luxembourg (November 2020), and Aarhus (April 2021). Approaches, methodologies, challenges and case studies have already been selected and a great deal of work has already begun. What results have we generated so far? What are the main challenges and achievements for each WG at this stage?
- Launch new projects, including two new WGs and a book project.
- Discuss challenges that web archives are currently facing, including questions of deletion and inclusion, the lack of activity and infrastructure in some countries, etc.
- Encourage us all to come up with new ideas related to the points above, and consider next steps both for the field and for WARCnet.

#### Therefore, within the meeting there are four types of sessions:

- o Keynotes.
- WG brainstorming sessions.
- WG presentations to other WGs, gathering together all WARCnet participants (research questions, methodologies, case studies, challenges, achievements, future work and planned outreach).
- Common sessions, gathering all WARCnet participants together, to promote coordination between WGs and address key issues such as public engagement.

Common sessions are rounded off by a brief discussion of what the network could be doing, based on the presentations and the already formulated tasks.

The meeting will end with a brief business meeting to address administrative matters.

## **Practicalities**

Venue: The conference will be a hybrid event, with some members of the group meeting in Aarhus and others joining via Zoom. You can find information about getting to the venue and Zoom invitations at the end of this program.

Keynotes are open to a wider public, therefore people from outside the network will be joining the sessions.

#### Getting to the venue

You may want to walk, which takes app. 45 minutes, the address is Helsingforsgade 14. Or you can take bus no. 2A, heading towards 'AUH Skejby' (indicated at the front of the bus). We recommend you download the app 'Midttrafik' (name of the bus company) and buy your ticket there (2 zones, adult), in the menu item 'Min konto' you can change language to English ('Skift sprog'). Otherwise, tickets can only be purchased in the ticket machine in the middle of the bus (coins and self service only), 22 DKK. You should get of the bus at Storcenter Nord.
